

OUTREACH MINISTRY

Purpose: The Outreach ministry team is focused on the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19) to go and make disciples of our community members, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that Jesus has commanded. To this end, the Outreach ministry team:

- welcomes and encourages others to welcome visitors to the church and church sponsored events
- meets with visitors in their homes to welcome them to the church
- encourages visitors and non-members to engage in church activities and ministries
- encourages visitors and non-members to become members of the church
- prays for and witnesses to the unchurched for the purpose of dedicating (or rededicating) their lives to Christ
- coordinates with other ministries in the church to present an outward invitation to community members to engage in church ministry

The Outreach ministry team is responsible for:

- coordinating with Worship Team Ministry welcoming visitors at worship and events
- meeting visitors, assessing their interest, praying with them and facilitating a decision of faith and/or community
- educating visitors on church activities and ministries such as Men's Fellowship, Women's Connection, small groups, mission-related projects, programs for healing and spiritual well-being, all with an emphasis on participation and fellowship
